What is DELE?

DELE (The Diploma For Spanish as a Foreign Language) is an **official Spanish diploma**, awarded by the *Instituto Cervantes* on behalf of the Spanish Ministry of Education.

The DELE examinations are designed following the directives of the Reference of the Common European Framework (MCER) and the Manual for relating exams to the MCER, both of them works of the European Council.

The DELE Diplomas cover all the levels A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 and C2 of the MCER.

The Spanish DELE diploma has **indefinite official validity and applicability** and **international recognition**.

DELE at the UPM

The UPM Language Centre is an Examinations Centre for DELE and organizes calls every year in MAY, JULY and NOVEMBER.

Inscriptions are made on the Web page of the *Instituto Cervantes*: <https://exámenes.cervantes.es/es/user/register>.

The **examinations** take place in one of the schools of the UPM. At the end of the inscription period, the UPM will send the official call to

the candidates in which the exact location tests is detailed.

The **written exams** will take place on the day announced by the *Instituto Cervantes* in each call.

The oral exams will take place during the previous class days or after the holding of the written exam.

It is not necessary to be a member of the UPM to take the exam in our centre. The call is open to anyone interested in taking the exam.

The prices depend on the level chosen and the payment is made on making the inscription on the Web page of the *Instituto Cervantes*.
